SHOW REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 Entries will be taken on the day.
- 2 The organisers shall not be liable for any claims in respect of damage or accident to any person, whether competitor, servant, or spectator, horse, vehicle or property, howsoever caused in connection with or arising out of the show.
- 3 The organisers retain the right to refuse any entry.
- 4 Competitors must wear correct riding clothing in accordance with Rule 101 1-3.
- 5 No rider may carry, use or permit to be used, a whip exceeding 30 inches in length or less than 18 inches in length.
- 6 Any objections must be made to the secretary within 30 minutes after the completion of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £100 which may be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
- 7 The decision of the judges is final on all points.
- 8 In the event of a horse which has been entered being unable to compete, 50% of the fee will be refunded (or substitution allowed in accordance with British Showjumping rules).
- 9 All owners and riders, or where applicable, parents and guardians, of horses competing in any jumping competition in the show, shall be deemed to be the subject to the rules and regulations of the British Showjumping, as if each of them were a member of the Association.
- 10 In the event of insufficient funds, lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.6.
- 11 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes at their discretion.
- 12 All dogs must be kept on leads.
- 13 No motor cycles or ball games are permitted on the show ground.
- 14 All entries are confined to horses/ ponies registered by the British Showjumping and ridden by members in accordance with Rule 79.
- 15 The submission of an entry will be deemed to include acceptance of the conditions.

Extra Notes

- a) In all events/ classes they are run under equivalent British Showjumping Rules.
- b) In all cases the decision of the judge will be final.
- c) Ponies 14.2 (148cm) and under will only be allowed to jump in horse classes according to British Showjumping Rules.

- a. The Society will not be held responsible for any accident, injury, damage or loss however caused, that may occur to any exhibitor or handler, or to any animal, article, damage or property brought onto the Show-ground, whilst entering or leaving or being carried out, or in the said Showground.
- b. Each exhibitor is solely responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may be done to, or occasioned by, or arising from any animal, article, or property exhibited or brought on to the Showground themselves, and will indemnify and hold harmless the Society from and against all actions, suits, expenses and claims on account of, or in respect of, any such damage or injury which may be caused or occasioned.
- **c.** It is recommended that exhibitors insure against fire and other liabilities as the exhibitor may incur under these Regulations.
- d. Exhibitors should undertake a risk assessment where relevant of their activities, which would be retained for use at all shows throughout the year.
